ROUTE CHANGES FOR McDONALDS GRAFTON TO INVERELL

Competitors in next month's McDonalds Grafton to Inverell Cycle Classic will enter both Glen Innes and Inverell through different routes than normal.

Race Director Scott Sunderland says Glen Innes, which is 160 kilometres into the race, will have its sprint relocated adjacent to the Standing Stones entrance on the Gwydir Highway at the eastern gateway to the town.

He said cyclists will continue the long descent down the Highway, cross the New England Highway and travel around the famous Glen Innes parklands before moving back on to the Gwydir Highway.

Mr.Sunderland said what was until this year the final testing climb on the course at Wire Gully, 18 kilometres from Inverell, will now be the penultimate climb.

On the western descent of Wire Gully, the field will detour left and travel through the small village of Elsmore before tackling the final climb out of the valley on Gibsons Hill.

He said this will add a new dimension to the McDonalds Grafton to Inverell which will be held on the 22nd of October.
