The SRAM NRS team will bring eight vehicles in total to cover the two races. They have two Skoda Octavia wagons which will have complete bicycles as well as ZIPP 404 carbon wheels on the roof racks. They will also have two Piaggio 400cc scooters which will carry the ZIPP 404 wheels as well. The scooters will play a vital part in getting the fastest possible service to any rider that happens to puncture during the 228km race.

The SRAM NRS have a rotating staff of fifteen experienced mechanics who travel to most major cycling events in Australia including the Sun Herald Tour and National Championships. They will also bring two vans and a truck to transport the spare bikes, ZIPP wheels and other equipment.



Race Director Rob Munday welcomed the SRAM NRS team attendance saying it will be a major boost to the smooth running of the event.



Mr Munday said "The riders will get the best Neutral Race Support available. The service that a rider will receive in the event of a mishap will be comparable to that of European races."
