

Timing Chips

Cycling NSW will again be providing transponders for this years event.

However, because of State Government regulations which state that if an event is officially timed it shall be deemed a race and all traffic management and traffic control measures MUST be put in place. Therefore times are NOT permitted to be recorded or published.

The organizing committee still requested Cycling NSW to provide the chips as a safety measure only, so that they know all riders have arrived in Inverell safely.

Please note that if you want an accurate record of your time for the ride **YOU MUST DO YOUR OWN TIMING.**

Cyclists Safety

Please Note : All NSW Road Rules apply. Riders must only ride 2 abreast and will not occupy more than half a lane on the correct side of the roadway at all times.

RIDERS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO RECEIVE SUPPORT WHILST MOVING . The rider must dismount and be at least 3 metres from the road way before receiving support.

NOTE : All riders from Grafton are **required to have rear flashing tail lights** as rain and / or foggy conditions maybe encountered on and prior to the Gibraltar Range.

Water Stations

G2I Organizers will provide fluid stations and mechanical assistance in this area at

- the base of the range
- Heffrons Lookout

Riders must dismount and fill biddons from the water station.

Support Vehicles

A full information sheet will be provided in the riders packs that they will receive at sign on.

We ask that all instructions be followed so as to reduce the risk of injury to riders, supporters and all members of the public.

RTA staff and Police will be on duty to ensure instructions are followed.

Please note : support vehicles are not permitted to stop within the 50km section of the route between Mann river caravan park (Jackadgery) and the rangers hut. this includes Heffrons lookout on the Gibraltar range climb

Support vehicles for riders from Grafton are NOT permitted to follow the riders but MUST go ahead and stop only at designated areas. (These areas will be clearly signposted)

Support vehicles must park at least 3 metres beyond the fog line at :

- Mann River Caravan Park , Jackadgery (45km)
- The Rangers Hut (95km). Approx 5km after the Gibraltar Range Summit
- Mount Mitchell Correctional Facility (115km)

Support vehicles handling end group riders may leap frog your rider in 15 km - 20 km sections
ONLY ONCE YOUR RIDER HAS PASSED THE RANGERS HUT .

- You must park more than 3 metres off the road as it allows.
- The rider must dismount and move off the carriageway at least 3 metres before receiving support.
- You are still NOT permitted to follow your rider on the road.
